

Important Budget Vote and Board Election Information

By Executive Order, there will be no voting at the School District this year. All voting will be done using Absentee Ballots. If you have voted on the School Budget in the last three years, you will be mailed an Absentee Ballot and a prepaid return envelope. If you have not voted in the past, but would like to this year, please e-mail the District Clerk at KHinkle@candorcs.org or call the District Office at 659-5010 to request an Absentee Ballot.

All Absentee Ballots will need to be mailed to the District, or dropped off at the Main Entrance of the High School, by **5:00 PM on Tuesday, June 9th, 2020**. Any ballot received after 5:00 PM on 6/9/20, can not be accepted.

The annual Budget Hearing will be held on Monday, June 1st, 2020 at 6:00 PM. The Hearing will be held online. Information on how to join the Hearing online will be posted on the District website on or before Wednesday, May 27th. If you have questions regarding the Hearing or how to join, please email the District Clerk or call the District Office.
