

NOTICE OF BUDGET HEARING AND VOTE
CANDOR CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

Budget Hearing

A budget hearing, for the inhabitants of the Candor Central School District qualified to vote at School District meetings, will be held **virtually pursuant to Executive Order 202.15, commencing at 6:00 p.m., on Monday, June 1, 2020**, where there shall be presented the proposed school district budget for the following school year.

Date of Vote

The vote upon the appropriation of the necessary funds to meet the estimated expenditures or for any propositions involving the expenditure of money or the authorizing of levy of taxes, as well as the election of members of the Board of Education, shall be held on Tuesday, **June 9, 2020**, and will take place remotely. Qualified voters will vote only by absentee ballot. Ballots will automatically be mailed to anyone that voted in the last three years. If you have not voted in the last three years and would like to receive an absentee ballot, please contact the District Clerk at 659-5010 or KHinkle@candorcs.org. Absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk by 5:00 pm on June 9, 2020.

Statement of Money Required for Next School Year

A copy of the statement of the amount of money which would be required for the next school year for school purposes shall be completed seven days before the budget hearing and may be obtained by any resident of the District at each schoolhouse during the period of 14 days immediately before the annual meeting and election, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., except Saturday, Sunday or holiday.

Vote for Board of Education Members

Nominations for candidates for the Board of Education must be filed with the Clerk of the District not later than May 11, 2020 at 5:00 pm.

District residents may self-nominate for the position of candidate for the Board of Education. To do so, a district resident must e-mail or call the District Clerk before 5:00 pm on Monday, May 11, 2020.

The following vacancies are to be filled:

A three-year term ending June 30, 2023, presently held by Mr. Josh Soper;

and

A three-year term ending June 30, 2023, presently held by Mr. Nate Brace.

All candidates will be placed on the ballot in alphabetical order.
